AFCC News & Reports – February 2020 #2: AFCC Begins Advocacy for FY2020 Federal Agency Appropriations

The Alternative Fuel & Chemicals Coalition (AFCC) has begun its advocacy efforts to secure sufficient funding for federal agency programs that are important to its member companies for fiscal year (FY) 2021.

AFCC has identified 37 programs that are "industry-critical" priorities for its member companies. This is because the authorizations or appropriations for these programs have expired and not been renewed, or because these programs have been targeted for significant cuts or elimination in the President's Budget.

Updated summary and detailed tables for the 53 programs that are important to AFCC's member companies have been posted on AFCC's website. They

Individual appropriation requests are available for each of the 37 programs that AFFC has identified as "industry critical." These requests mimic member office appropriation request forms. They can be viewed and downloaded at: https://www.altfuelchem.org/fy2021-industry-critical-requests.

The appropriation subcommittees overseeing these programs are:

- **Agriculture:** 10 programs, <u>6 of which are "industry-critical" priorities</u>
- Commerce, Science, and Justice: 11 programs, 4 of which are "industry-critical" priorities
- Energy and Water: 8 programs, 8 of which are "industry-critical" priorities
- **Interior and Environment:** 11 programs, 9 of which are "industry-critical" priorities
- **Transportation:** 13 programs, 10 of which are "industry-critical" priorities
